Global21 is proud to announce the addition of three new chapters to its network: University of South Australia (*South Australia Globalist*), The London School of Economics (*London Globalist*), and Oxford University (name TBA). Each of these initiatives has progressed rapidly over the past year: all three were established in the fall of 2009 and are on schedule to publish their first issues by mid-summer 2010. With the addition of these universities, the Global21 network totals 11 universities, reaching 212,000 students on five continents.



These initiatives are part of Global21's ambitious plan to expand the network to eighteen magazines spanning fifteen countries by 2012. Already, Global21 is working closely with teams at the Instituto Tecnológico Autónomo de México in Mexico City, Ibmecc in Rio de Janeiro, St. Stephen's University in Delhi, and Utrecht University in Utrecht. Nascent efforts are also underway to establish a multi-university magazine in Hong Kong.
